
Envelope Church Craft Instructions

- 1. Print out the church pattern. Color it in.
- 2. Cut out the shapes. You should have 6 separate pieces (the church "envelope" shape, the door, cross, 2 windows, and the words "here's the church).
- 3. Fold the big envelope shape. Fold the pieces in so you cover the pulpit in the middle. On the top-most part of the envelope, fold the dotted line back, forming a small triangle.



- 4. Glue the very bottom of the cross on the small folded triangle. The top of the cross will stick out and not be glued to anything.
- 5. Glue a window on each of the sides.
- 6. Glue the doors on the outside bottom. The top of the door should stick out over the bottom of the envelope shape.
- 7. Glue the words "here's the church" on the outside top.
- 8. Open the envelope and add people to your drawing. I added congregation members, a choir and a pastor, but you can add whatever you want.
- 9. Fold it all up and then you have it ready to go.
