Nursery Care

We are pleased to welcome Kathee and Amanda back to the nursery. Childcare for infants through early pre-school will be available during the worship service.

Pre-K through 2nd grade

Children in preschool through second grade will meet in room 110 and follow the Summer Sunday School format, which focuses on fellowship. There are no prepared lessons, but children will have the opportunity to socialize and enjoy our outdoor playground equipment. Our goal will be to remain outdoors on the playground as much as possible, but we will use Room 110 for inclement weather. Masks will be required to be worn for everyone whether indoors or outdoors. 3rd - 8th grade

Initially, we will have our tween / preteen group meet in room 110 with the younger kids. The kids will serve as junior helpers as needed with the younger group. Once we have adult volunteers lined up as our participant numbers increase, we will have this group meet on the front church lawn for organized games and activities. Our goal will be to remain outdoors on the lawn as much as possible, but we will use Fellowship Hall for inclement weather. Masks will be required to be worn for everyone whether indoors or outdoors. 9th - 12th grade

Our high school youth group will meet a few times a month, with varying times and locations. Our meetings will be mostly outdoors, and when we do meet indoors, safety procedures will be in place. Please check text messages through the GroupMe app and your email for meeting details.

Overview of Safety Procedures

This is an overview of the plan. Please read the complete procedures posted on the website for details. We have implemented new cleaning protocols and procedures to ensure the safety of children and volunteers. In general, the procedures we are implementing will require masks for everyone 3 years and older, and we will practice social distancing during seated activities. Handsanitizing and cleaning stations will be set up, and we will require kids to wash their hands after using the playground equipment. We will minimize the sharing of craft supplies and toys. We will not do temperature checks, but will ask folks if they don't feel well to stay home. The final aspect of our procedure involves cleaning and disinfecting high-touch surfaces and cleaning procedures in the classroom area between uses.
